

Photo Upload and Crop

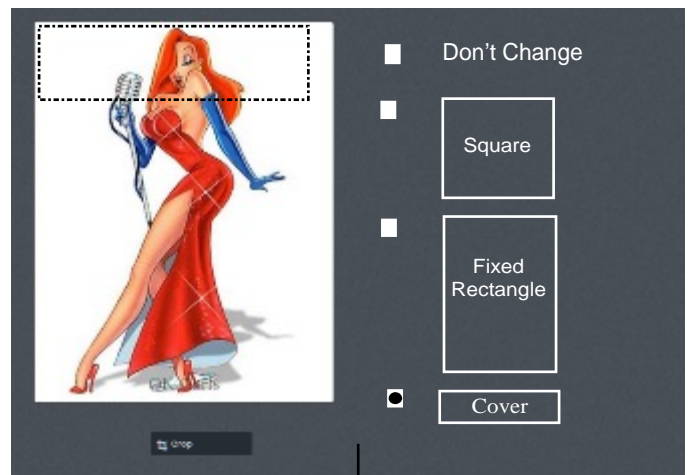
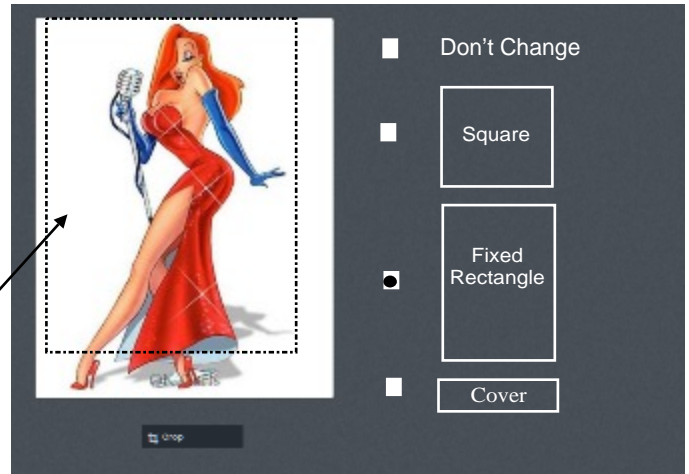
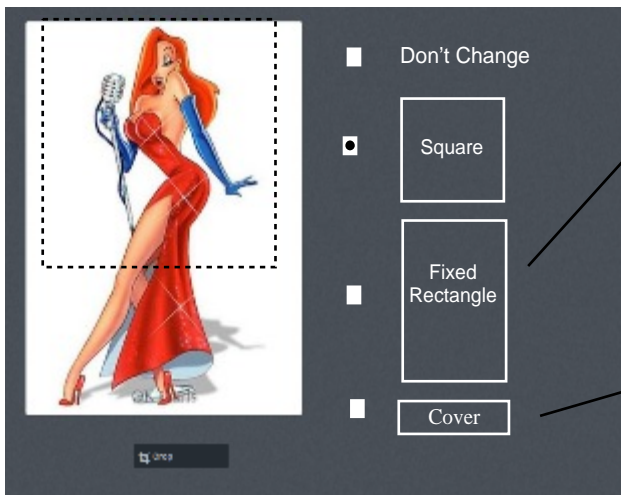
Either keep the same size, or select one of the pre-set crops opposite.

Note: Original will be replaced with cropped image.

1. Add photo



2. Choose Ratio and crop photo



This is a simple “follow-on” process that will go a long way to improve the usefulness of the photo module which needs a lot of work.

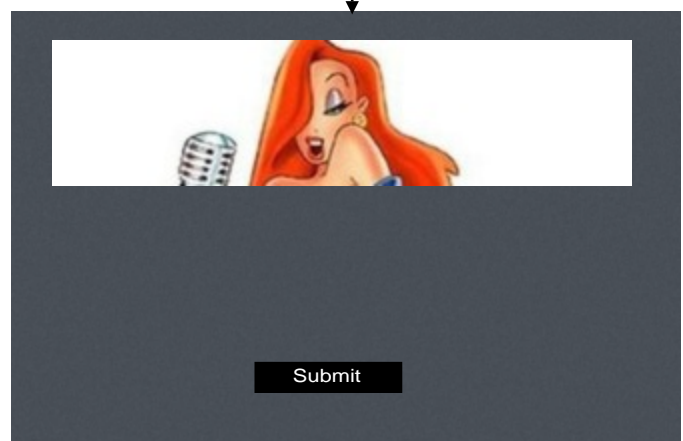
It will not only resolve the cover photo issue, it would also be a great feature for Dolphin.

One assumes you can simply use the existing crop feature for profile pics, but add two extra shapes.

Ideally the rectangle should be flexible, but a pre-set would be okay. Just use the Golden rectangle formula (A4 paper).

The Cover crop could be selected only when a cover photo is being added.

3. Submit

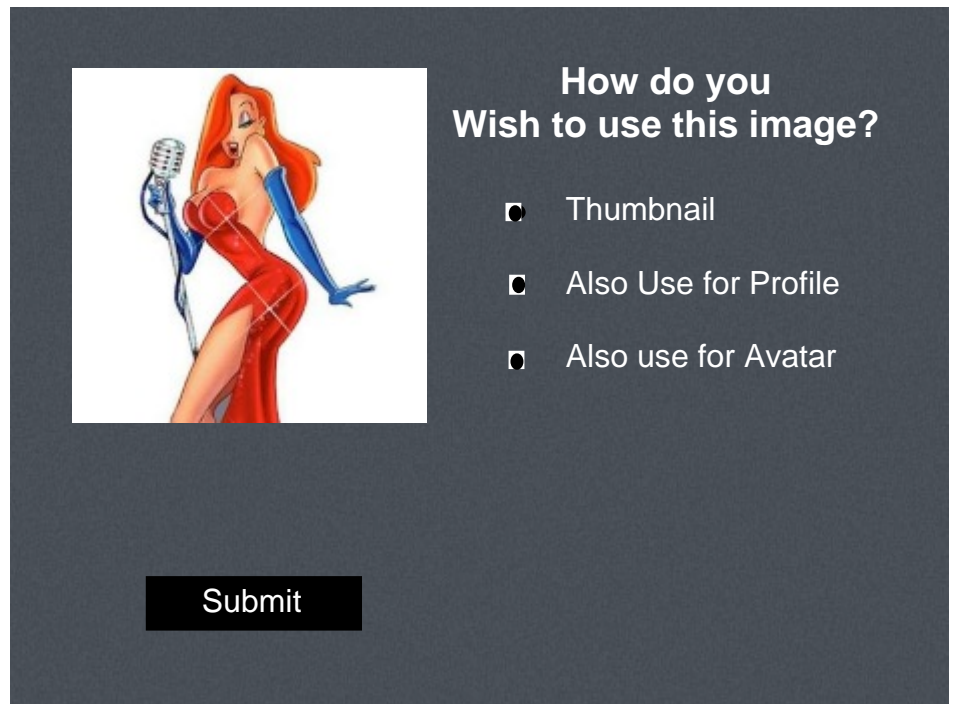
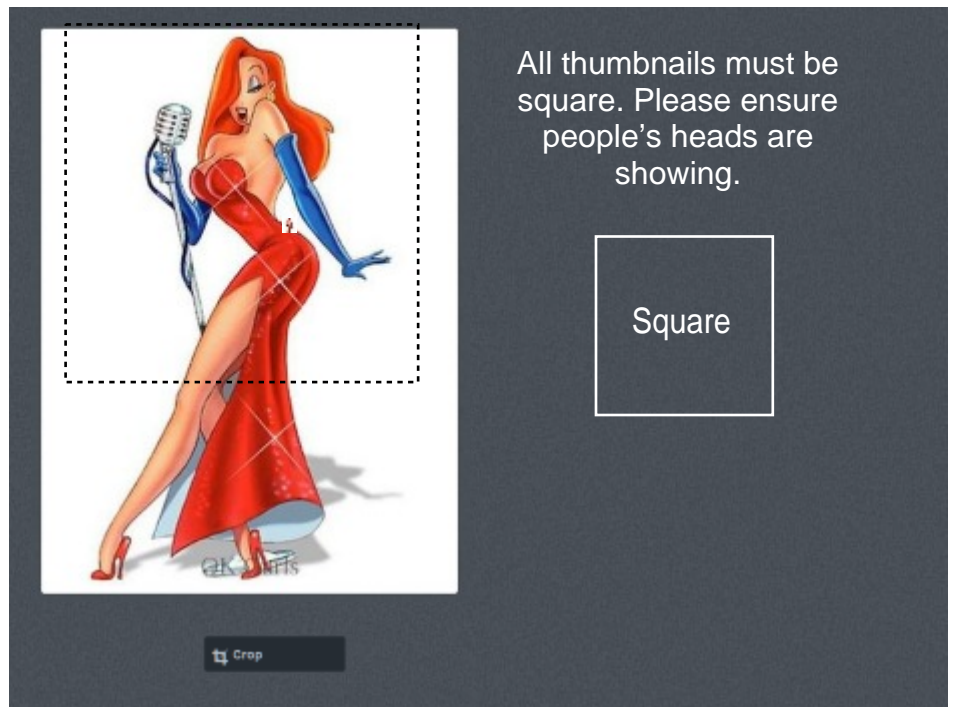
Thumb Crop

This appears once a photo has been submitted.

Ideally it should also be accessible at any time a photo is selected for editing.

Please compare this with the current Photo Module.

Any user can understand this logic after the first use.



This is the standard Profile Pic crop routine with a few small additions.

Flow Chart:

1. Click + sign to upload image
2. Select an image and upload it.
3. Crop the image
4. Submit
5. Thumb crop screen appears
6. Crop the Thumb and choose purpose(s)
7. Submit
