Adding a Photo to an HTML Block

This is a basic tutorial in response to a question on the forum. I'll expand on it later if there's any additional interest.

It's essential to understand that the photo you plan to use is stored in your Dolphin Directory on your server. TinyMice does not allow you to use files stored elsewhere.

I always store my images in the Images directory in my current template module. Even if you decide to use a different template, the photo will still be available provided you don't delete the template fiolder.

Thus, before you start, FTP your image to your **templates/tmpl_evo (or whatever)/images** directory.

Now go to **Admin/Builders/Pages Builder** and select the page where you want to place the HTML Block from the dropdown list.

I've chosen Profile.

Drag a **HTML Block** from the Inactive Items section and place it in one of the columns on your page.
