

Tutorial - How to setup Dolphin Cupid Match

Step 1. Settings

- * Go to Administration/Settings/Advanced Setting.
- * Click on Matches.
- * Enable matchmaking
- * Enable view match percent for profiles
- * Enter 85 in Send a cupid mail if the recently joined profile matches more than this percentage.
- * Save







NOTE: For demonstration purposes we will use the below percentages for Match percent.

Country = 30

Sex = 10

LookingFor = 10

PTest1Type = 25

LookingForPTest1Type = 25

Step 3. How to set up "Country" profile field for Cupid Match.

* Click on the "Country" Profile field and it will pop open on your screen.

NOTE: Make sure the sum of the Match Percentages totals 100. The higher the percentage the more important the field is.

* Click on Country - Field - Matching.

* Match with field: Choose Country from drop down box.

NOTE: When setting up profile fields for cupid match set them up the same as Step 3. for Country, choosing the same profile field in the "Match with field" eg. Country with Country.

The exceptions to the rule are:

Sex with LookingFor

LookingFor with Sex
 PTest1Type with LookingForPTest1Type
 LookingForPTest1Type with PTest1Type

Step 4. How to set up "Sex" profile field for Cupid Match.

* Click on the "Sex" Profile field and it will pop open on your screen.
